## Student group wants fans to learn words of PSU songs

SOS's "For the Glory ... Know the Words" campaign aims to teach Penn State football fans the fight songs "The Nittany Lion" and "Fight On, State."

"So what if they put the lyrics on the screen?" said SOS founder Tom Shakely. "No one says them."

Shakely said SOS will distribute 40,000 copies of these songs around campus this week.

"We realize this is an ambitious campaign to try to get the stadium to learn the songs in the space of five days," Shakely added. "Even if 10 percent of the students sing the songs, that's a victory."

SOS will coordinate song-singing activities at Paternoville on Thursday night to "communicate to others who we are as Penn Staters," Shakely said.

"Penn State is the premier land grant institution in the world," he added. "'This is our humble way to say we should start acting like it.'"
